"I wrote the book to help others understand that during trials - quite literally in my case - and tribulations, their belief in God's Word is being tested," said Mitchell.

From practicing a healthy lifestyle to releasing hurt in prayer, Mitchell's words speak volumes about the ability of the human spirit - courtesy God - to conquer and find comfort. Her final parting thoughts share what she learned from the challenge, how she emerged stronger and offer encouragement to others who may feel lost.
